Method

Prepare filling. Soak the rice paper in warm water until just softened. Remove from the bowl and place on a plate. Divide filling and add each portion of rice paper. Fold over rice paper and roll up, pressing edge to seal. Repeat with remaining ingredients. Cut rolls in half and serve with sweet chilli sauce.
